Let no one deceive you in any way. 1 Timothy 4:1-3

Now the Spirit expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons, ²through the insincerity of liars whose consciences are seared, 3who forbid marriage and require abstinence from foods that God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth.

The Church as the Temple of God

1 Corinthians 3:16 "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?"

2 Corinthians 6:16 "What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people."

Deuteronomy 13:1-3
